Frequently Asked Questions

Q. What is TFCU Gives?

A. TFCU Gives is the credit union's philanthropic program through which all donations to local nonprofits are made.

Q. Does TFCU still have the Community Partnership Awards program?

- A. The program ended in 2019 and now all donations are made through TFCU Gives.
- Q. Does TFCU support only organizations that have a 501(c)(3) designation by the Internal Revenue Service?
- A. No, TFCU also considers support for organizations that provide a copy of the Internal Revenue Service's designation that states the reasons that donations to the organization are considered by law to be tax deductible.

Q. Will TFCU accept our organization's Employer Identification Number (EID #) as proof of our tax-exempt status?

A. No, the EID # will not be accepted as proof that donations made to the organization are considered by law to be tax deductible.

Q. If my organization was previously funded by TFCU, do I need to submit my application again?

A. Yes. Local nonprofits who can prove existence in Pima County for at least two years, and who have proof of an official designation by the Internal Revenue Service, are welcome to submit online applications at any time whether they have received a donation from TFCU Gives in the past.

Q. Are there any limits to the donation amount that can be requested?

A. No, the nonprofit may request any amount for consideration.

Q. Are applications accepted only at one time during the year?

A. Requests for funding are accepted and reviewed monthly from January through December.

Q. Will I be notified if my request is not funded?

A. Yes, each nonprofit is notified by email if the application is approved or declined.
