



Q. What is TFCU Gives?

TFCU Gives is the credit union's philanthropic program through which all donations to local nonprofits are made.

Q. Does TFCU support only organizations that have a 501(c)(3) designation by the Internal Revenue Service?

While TFCU prioritizes 501(c)(3) organizations, it also considers support for organizations that provide a copy of an Internal Revenue Service designation stating the specific legal reasons why donations to that organization are tax deductible.

Q. Are there specific longevity requirements for tax-exempt status?

Yes. To be eligible for funding, an organization must have held its official 501(c)(3) designation (or other qualifying IRS tax-deductible status) for at least two consecutive years.

Q. Will TFCU accept our organization's Employer Identification Number (EIN) as proof of our tax-exempt status?

No. An EIN will not be accepted as proof that donations made to the organization are considered tax deductible by law.

Q. If my organization was previously funded by TFCU, do I need to submit my application again?

Yes. Local nonprofits that can prove an active existence in Pima County for at least two years and have maintained their official IRS tax-deductible designation for at least two years are welcome to submit online applications at any time, regardless of past funding.

Q. Are there any limits to the donation amount that can be requested?

No. A nonprofit may request any amount for consideration.

Q. Are applications accepted only at one time during the year?

No. Requests for funding are accepted and reviewed on a monthly basis from January through December.

Q. Will I be notified if my request is not funded?

Yes. Each nonprofit is notified by email whether their application is approved or declined.
